100th Avenue NE & NE 10th Street Mini-Roundabout

Construction Feb-May 2020; Intersection closure planned for 28 days

As part of the 100th Avenue NE Complete Streets project, an existing stop-controlled intersection will be replaced with a mini-roundabout at the intersection of 100th Avenue NE at NE 10th Street. Features of the roundabout will help to reduce collisions and improve pedestrian safety.

Schedule and impacts: Construction is anticipated February through May 2020. The intersection will be closed for approximately 28 consecutive calendar days to accelerate construction. Detours will be in place during the closure. Construction schedule is subject to change.

- **Work hours** are anticipated to be Monday-Friday, 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. and Saturday-Sunday, 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. when the intersection is closed.
- **Intersection closure** dates will be posted on project signs prior to the start of construction and on the city's traffic advisories webpage at BellevueWA.gov/trafficadvisories.
- **Lane closures** with flagging operations will be Monday-Friday, from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. when the intersection is open.

Please follow flaggers' instruction and traffic control signs, including detour signs.


