NE Spring Blvd - 130th to 132nd Avenue NE

As part of the NE Spring Boulevard Corridor Improvement project, the Bellevue Transportation Department plans to:

What to expect

- **Schedule:** Construction February 2022 through March 2023. Schedule is subject to change.
- **Traffic impact:** Shoulder and lane closures on 130th Avenue NE and on 132nd Avenue NE. A one-week closure of 130th Avenue NE at NE Spring Boulevard will be required to complete the signal and the intersection.
- Approved work hours: Mon.-Fri. 7 a.m.-6 p.m.

Funding

Funding comes from the city's 2021-2027 Capital Investment Program and a federal Transportation Infrastructure Finance and Innovation Act (TIFIA) loan. Estimated cost is \$16 million.


Build one new eastbound and one westbound travel lane on NE Spring Blvd between 130th and 132nd avenues

Build buffered bike lanes and a sidewalk in each direction


