



CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Bellevue Transit Center Raised Intersections

Description

This project includes the construction of new raised intersections at 108th and 110th Avenues NE at NE 6th Street to provide a seamless street crossing for people walking and rolling between the East Link light rail station and the Bellevue Transit Center.

This project advances implementation of The Grand Connection vision to build an engaging, people-oriented experience along a dedicated route from Meydenbauer Bay Park through downtown to Eastrail. For more information, visit BellevueWA.gov/grandconnection.

Impacts

- **Construction:** Anticipated to begin in May 2023. Expected completion Fall 2023.
- **Work hours:** Monday-Friday, 9 a.m.-3 p.m.
- **Traffic impacts:** During this phase of construction, there will be daytime lane closures.

Replace water main under 10th Ave NE at NE 6th Street




