

Property Tax Levies Impacting Bellevue (\$ million)			
Bellevue School District	\$132.1	32%	} 56%
State Schools	\$100.6	24%	
King County Non Voted	\$ 50.3	12%	} 21%
King County Voted Levies	\$ 37.0	9%	
<b>City of Bellevue</b>	<b>\$ 56.5</b>	<b>13%</b>	
King County Library System	\$ 22.3	5%	
Sound Transit 3	\$ 12.4	3%	
Port of Seattle	\$ 7.6	2%	
<b>Total</b>	<b>\$418.8</b>	<b>100%</b>
