EAST BELLEVUE COMMUNITY MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON RESOLUTION NO. 152

A RESOLUTION of the East Bellevue Community Council approving Ordinance No. 2954 adopted by the Bellevue City Council relating to an amendment to the Land Use Code and Shoreline Master Program relating to the length of private piers; permitting any private pier to extend 80 feet beyond the ordinary high water mark, and requiring an administrative conditional use permit for piers proposed beyond this point to ten feet in water depth or 150 feet, whichever is less.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bellevue, Washington did pass Ordinance No. 2954 on the 2nd day of March, 1981, and

WHEREAS, the subject matter of said Ordinance falls within the jurisdiction of the East Bellevue Community Council pursuant to RCW 35.14.040, and

WHEREAS, following public hearing held before the East Bellevue Community Council on April 7, 1981, the Community Council did vote to approve Bellevue Ordinance No. 2954.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Community Council of the East Bellevue Community Municipal Corporation of the City of Bellevue, Washington:

Section 1. The Findings, Conclusions and Conditions adopted by the Bellevue City Council relative to Ordinance No. 2954 are hereby adopted by the East Bellevue Community Council as thoughtfully set forth herein.

Section 2. Ordinance No. 2954 of the Bellevue City Council is hereby approved.

Section 3. The Clerk is hereby directed to certify the original of this Resolution, to file the same and to keep the same on file in her office. The Clerk is further directed to distribute certified or conformed copies of this Resolution to the Bellevue City Council and the Bellevue Planning Department.
