## CITY OF BELLEVUE EAST BELLEVUE COMMUNITY COUNCIL

Resolution No. 226

A RESOLUTION reaffirming the intent of the East Bellevue Community Council regarding the residential character of the community.

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue began its comprehensive planning process in 1972, which process has continued to the present and has not yet been completed; and

WHEREAS, the Comprehensive Plan Advisory Committee appointed by the City Council in 1972 to develop the City's Comprehensive Plan involved the greatest citizen participation of any project in the City's history; and

WHEREAS, this dedicated group of citizens brought forward the proposition, which a subsequent City Council reaffirmed, that the primary goal of Bellevue's Comprehensive Plan is as set forth in Bellevue Comprehensive Plan Goal 21.B.000; and

WHEREAS, the East Bellevue Community Council has from the outset strongly supported Comprehensive Plan Goal 21.B.000 as the key and dominant element of the Comprehensive Plan and now desires to reaffirm that commitment,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The East Bellevue Community Council reaffirms that it is its intent that the City of Bellevue remain primarily a suburban single family residential community served by a Central Business District and other supportive activities, and that the policies of the Comprehensive Plan are intended to implement that goal.

Section 2: The Clerk is hereby directed to certify the original of this resolution, to file the same, and to keep the same on file in her office.
