A RESOLUTION urging the Bellevue School District to provide additional pedestrian access to Odle Junior High School via the right-of-way for N.E. 4th Street.

WHEREAS, currently used routes are inadequate, and,

THE EAST BELLEVUE COMMUNITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The East Bellevue Community Council endorses and urges the provision of additional pedestrian access to Odle Junior High School via the existing right-of-way for N.E. 4th Street from 140th Avenue N.E.

Section 2. The Clerk is hereby directed to certify the original of this resolution, to file the same, and to keep the same on file in her office.
