
THE EAST BELLEVUE COMMUNITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON,

Section 1. City Council Ordinances 2173 and 2209 are hereby approved.


Section 2. The Clerk is hereby directed to certify the original of this resolution, to file the same, and to keep the same on file in her office.
