The flyer sent to my house says "75% of respondents either are moving into the neighborhood or not traveling anywhere between 4-7 PM" The way this survey is structured, you cannot respond that you are both moving into and out of the neighborhood by multiple modes of transportation during this time period, which is what I lot of the "working population" of this hill does. I do not believe this survey is an accurate representation of my neighborhood which is includes the condominiums, apartments, and townhouses bordered by SE 30th, 125th AVE SE, and SE 32nd Street. This area is the most densely populated area of this hill (and likely has the highest % of workers per household in all of Woodridge). I suspect your survey was heavily slanted toward the retirees on this hill who can afford to "just stay at home" while the traffic is bad. Retired or part time workers also have more "time" to attend open houses. These restrictions will only make it harder for me to get home or go get groceries after work. My work day is long enough already. Now I have to wait until 7 PM to be able to go get groceries (by car since I need a car to carry the amount of groceries I purchase) after I arrive home by bus and walk a 1/2 mile to my house. How is this fair? The cars causing the backing up on 128th Ave NE are trips destined for I-90 westbound. Turn restrictions will not change the I-90 WB driver's ability to get there, it will only make it easier. People will not forget the option of going over the hill just because their smartphone does not route them there. There is backup onto 128th Ave SE because there is more demand to get onto I-90 westbound than there is ramp storage. 128th is effectively ramp storage. If you want to prevent cars from queuing onto 128th Ave SE, then close the ramp access from 128th and and SE 32nd from 4-7 PM. Don't punish the people who live in the most affordable housing on the hill and represent the highest concentration of transit users on the hill. If you want to reduce demand for WB I-90, then start tolling this entrance point for all vehicles except busses and officially registered vanpools. No exceptions for 2+ or 3+ carpools - the % of people cheating at the HOV on ramp to I-90 WB very high; I see a very high % of cheaters as I wait for the bus.

It hasn't impacted my travel out of Woodridge, as at that those hours I don't want to go anywhere near the Factoria area, and if I do I walk. At this point I'd love to see the signs become permanent coupled with more frequent enforcement. There does not need to be a sticker or exception for residents, it should continue to apply to all of us. IMO the real way to mitigate the back-up is better traffic light timing and adjustments on Richards Road and Factoria Blvd. That is the root cause of the traffic back-up, and there are plenty of minor tweaks that could be done there to get things flowing more smoothly.

These turn restrictions have a direct negative impact on me. I have lived in Woodridge for 20 years, and for the last 15 years I have had a regular commitment in Factoria on a weekday at 7pm. My most sensible route leads me to turn from 128th Ave SE to east-bound SE 32nd St. right around 6:45 or 6:50pm, which is exactly what has just been prohibited. If I instead turn down SE 26th St. onto Richards Rd., I expect I will encounter heavier and slower traffic, so that I will have to travel a little earlier, when the traffic is even heavier. I will thus be adding to the traffic congestion on Richards Rd. that has frustrated so many, rather than ameliorating it by taking an alternate route. Although I do not like having the turn restricted at all, I would be less bothered if the restriction ended at 6:30 or 6:45pm.

For the past week and half, since the revealment of the signs, I have not seen a single police officer to re-enforce the turn restriction or giving out tickets. Out of the 3-4 years working next to the Woodridge neighborhoods. It has gotten so bad I have had to find alternative routes and they are out of the way. If there was an officer to enforce these rules between 4 PM - 7 PM Monday to Friday, I can make it down the hill to make a turn onto Richard road without having to deal with cars honking at the road blocks.

Traffic levels appear to be lower, which is great. I understand that many in the neighborhood have been inconvenienced by through-traffic and I'm glad that steps are being taken to correct this. I'm seeing results on occasion, and also seeing a steady stream of traffic on others.

I do have some corrections to this approach that I believe would better server ALL in this community:

1. Residents on 30th and it's connecting streets should not be restricted from turning onto their own block to get home. How does this help anything? Who is making this decision? How many people from this street were involved?

However, and I'm sure the reason this policy went into place - 30th Street is entirely made up of apartments and condos - much lower income homes compared to the rest of the neighborhood. Have the privileged clan in charge overlooked this or disregarded it? How much did you reach out to this community, and did you consider the roadblocks that might be in place preventing people with a lower income than you from participating in these meetings?

2. The only time I have ever been significantly impacted by traffic on Woodridge has been when parents have been picking up children at Woodridge Elementary. Laws seem to be overlooked as cars line up on the street, creating the largest backup I've seen, not to mention extremely dangerous conditions for children.

I suspect the hover-parents whose children can't walk a few blocks to get to school are the same people freaking out over evening commuters, and drivers who don't belong in this neighborhood.

Ultimately, while it's nice to see results I believe race and equity need to be strongly considered in this matter. The privileged wealthy elite of Woodridge seem to be driving this issue. As I drove home tonight, following a stream of cars up Woodridge, a pack of white male tweens on bikes screamed at me and other cars as we passed. A learned behavior from an elite neighborhood closing in a bubble and serving themselves.

Please dive deeper into race and equity as you consider the restrictions you are placing on your neighbors.
