Start/Finish: Lake Hills Community Park, 1200 164th Avenue SE (164th Avenue SE & SE 16th Street)

To register: Please pre-register, space is limited.

Register online myParksandRecreation.com using Code #106268 or call 425-452-6885.

Day of event registration: Opens at 8 am; Start area open between 9–10 am
All participants must sign in/register. Course is well marked and supported by staff and volunteers.

Registration and Entry fees: \$15/pre-register; \$20/day of event

Aid station: Located on longer “Lake” Loop

Routes: Greenbelt Loop—mostly flat 9-mile route; Lake Loop—more challenging 22-mile route with some elevation gain. The routes are on-road and off-road (gravel).

Equipment: A bike that can handle some dirt and gravel is recommended. A bike mechanic from Gregg’s will be on site at the start to assist with safety checks and minor repairs. All riders must wear helmets.

Prizes/Schwag: Post-event prizes. First 300 to register will receive a custom-designed t-shirt.

Requirements: All participants must obey the rules of the road and trail. **Recommended for ages 8 & up (Greenbelt loop). All riders under age 18 must be accompanied by a responsible adult on all rides.**
